

**John Cook School of Business**  
**2011 Research Award**  
**Application Guidelines**

**Eligibility:** Cook School Faculty are eligible to apply for the 2011 Cook School Research Award if you have not won the award in 2009-10, 2008-09, 2007-08.

**Timeframe:** Research that has been published within the previous 5 calendar years for Associate and Full Professor, and the previous 3 calendar years for Assistant Professor. For example, for the 2011 Research Award, eligible research at the Assistant Professor level is research published (i.e., in print) in the calendar years of 2008, 2009 and 2010. The faculty applicant must provide the complete journal citations for all eligible research publications.

**Application:** Faculty should apply with the following documents: 1) completed JCSB Research Award Form (attached) and 2) a research vitae showing complete citations of all research activity.

**Due date and time:** Monday, April 4, 2011 by 5:00 p.m. Completed application packages should be submitted to Tom Miller, Jr., Sr. Fellow for Research and Faculty Development, DS 200, care of Ms. Christine Rogers.

**Evaluation:** JCSB “gold” publications will be assigned 5 points, “silver” publications 3 points, other refereed publications 1 point. Top point earners in each academic rank are eligible for award, with the Research Award Committee recommending winners to the Dean of the Cook School.
